



**Summary of Substantive Changes
between the updates dated October 17, 2012 and September 19, 2013 of
UL 8750, “Light Emitting Diode (LED) Equipment for Use in
Lighting Products”
(First edition, dated November 18, 2009)**

Presented to the IAPMO Standards Review Committee on November 4, 2013

General: The changes to this standard should not affect currently listed products. The substantive changes are:

- Added requirements for dimmable LED drivers for use with solid-state dimming controls electrically wired in series with the mains supply.

Section 8.3, Temperature test: Added new testing for LED drivers that are dimmable using a solid state dimming control (see Sections 8.3.19 to 8.3.22).

Section 9.3, Construction-related markings: Added new requirements for marking LED drivers that are dimmable using a solid state dimming control (see Sections 9.3.4 and 9.3.5).
