



**Summary of Substantive Changes
between the 2014 and the 2019 editions of
NSF/ANSI 177 “Shower Filtration Systems – Aesthetic Effects”**

Presented to the IAPMO Standards Review Committee on March 10, 2020

General: The change to this standard should not have an impact on currently listed products. The substantive change is:

- Clarified language for complying with the federal requirements for materials containing lead to match the rest of the drinking water treatment standards (see Section 4.1.1)

Section 4, Materials: Clarified language to bring the standard up to date with other related DWTU Standards as follows:

4.1 Materials in contact with shower water

.....

4.1.1 Complete formulation information on any material not certified as specifically compliant with the sections of the US Code of Federal Regulations, Title 21,⁶ listed in Table 4.1, shall be reviewed to determine whether the material contains lead as an intentional ingredient. As a minimum level of information for those materials requiring submission of formulation information, the complete chemical identity and ingredient sources of supply shall be provided.
